At School

- Removal of basketball towers

- Clean all spouts and drains
- Weeding of gardens

At Middle Gully

- Construction of doors to the maze at Middle Gully
- Erection of wire fence around new 'chook house' extension
- Repairs and extension to tree house
- Removal/pruning of trees, blackberries, broom and gorse
- Weeding of gardens
- Construction of new running/bike track through the jungle

There are ample tasks to be carried out inside and under the school if the weather is inclement.
